Bicycle Recycling Project

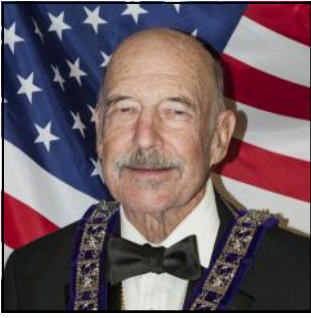
Our refurbishing and refitting of old bicycles is still going strong.

From the Station of Charity



Greetings fellow Elks,

Becky and I just returned from the 109th Annual Convention of the California-Hawaii Elks Association (including the Islands of Guam and Philippines), in Fresno, CA. This three day convention consisted of business sessions attended by leaders of the 168 Lodges from 19 Districts. Culver City Lodge is part of the South Central Coast District, which is comprised of six Lodges which includes the Santa Monica, Torrance, Westchester, Redondo Beach and Gardena Lodges. Congratulations to Sean Williams, who was installed as our 2024/2025 CHEA District Vice President.

The highlight of the affair, in my opinion, is the Piggy Bank March, which occurs on the final day, where our Exalted Rulers from every Lodge march up on the main stage and announce the year's total of money raised from their Lodge. At the time of writing this article, I don't have the totals for this year. Last year the 168 Lodges raised a total of about 4.5 million dollars. Our District (6 lodges) will donate about \$100,000 this year.

The Purple Pig is the fundraising arm of the California-Hawaii Elks Association Major Project, Inc. (CHEMPI). CHEMPI has raised over \$140.5 MILLION since 1950 to address the unmet needs of children with disabilities by developing a program of supporting services to aid these children at no cost to their families. This last year 37 paid therapists and preschool vision screeners, who are on the staff of CHEMPI, helped disabled children when no other organizations could or would. Our Occupational Therapists had a caseload of 150 and completed 4,445 visits; Physical Therapists with a caseload of 98 made 3,227 visits; Speech Pathologists 3,982 visits, and 43,830 Preschool Children's vision have been screened.

Your donations to our Purple Pig program really do make a difference! I hope to see you all at the Lodge
